KUALA LUMPUR: When Yang di-Pertuan Agong Al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin Al-Mustafa Billah Shah spontaneously left the royal dais to confer the award to Forest Research Institute Malaysia (FRIM) director-general Datuk Dr Abd Latif Mohmod, His Majesty's action really touched and overwhelmed the latter.
