BANGI: Dr Muhd Noor Muhd Yunus, the former deputy director-general of research and development programme in the Malaysian Nuclear Agency, has been elected the Malaysian Association of Research Scientists (MARS) president for the 2020-2022 term.

Muhd Noor was elected to the post at the association's annual general meeting last Friday to replace Dr Wan Manshol Wan Zin, MARS said in a statement Monday.
